

Saskatchewan College of Midwives - Midwifery Fee Bylaws

Title

1. These bylaws may be referred to as *The Midwifery Fee Bylaws, 2022*.

Definitions

2. In these bylaws, “licence year” means the calendar year.

Fees prescribed

3. The amounts set out in Table 1 are prescribed as the amounts of the fees for the purposes and licence years indicated, as authorized by clause 14(1)(m) of *The Midwifery Act*.

Pro-rated fees – commencing practice

4. Members, other than student members, commencing practice in the course of a year may have their annual licence fees pro-rated with respect to the portion of the year for which they are actually licensed.

Pro-rated fees – ceasing practice

5. Members who are proposing to cease practice in the course of a year may have their annual fees pro-rated with respect to the portion of the year after which they will cease to practice, which portion may not be less than three consecutive months.

Quarterly payments

6. Annual licence fees may be paid in quarterly instalments due on or before each of January 1, April 1, July 1 and October 1 of each year, in an amount equal to one-quarter of the annual licence fee for that year plus 5%, by providing post-dated cheques for the whole licence year on or before January 1.

Repeal

8. *The Midwifery Fee Bylaws, 2020* are hereby repealed.

Coming into force

9. In accordance with subsection 13(5) of *The Midwifery Act*, these bylaws come into force when they are made by the Council.
